Who We Are

Established in 1964 to create connections, collaborations and community around education and parenting, PCW is governed by a rotating volunteer Board of Directors. All members of the Board (16 at present) are parents of member school students or graduates, serving 3-year terms. The Board, with the help of a part-time administrator, organizes and coordinates all programs and resources.

Who We Serve

PCW is a nonprofit membership organization serving the interests of its member school communities. Eligible members are independent schools (Preschool-12) in the Washington, DC metropolitan area, paying annual dues based on type of school and enrollment, and appointing school representatives to liaison with PCW to benefit their school communities via programs, resources and networking opportunities.

PCW School Representatives

Specific Responsibilities/Expectations for Taking Advantage of PCW Membership

Each member school selects approximately one to three parents to serve as PCW Representatives during the academic year. Representatives are expected to learn about, advertise and promote, encourage participation, attend and engage, and share program materials for all applicable PCW programs with their school communities, as well as seek opportunities to promote the relationship between PCW, member schools, and parent groups.

- Take part in PCW Orientation
- Communicate with your PCW Board Member Liaison
- Read and act upon PCW monthly checklists sent directly to your email inbox
- Refer to PCW website (<u>www.parentscouncil.org</u>, 'Resources for Reps' section)
- Attend other PCW events (Speaker Events, Panel Discussions)

> Advertise and Promote

- Use blurbs from PCW monthly checklists to advertise in school communications
- Be strategic about where to advertise (school newsletters, class notices, etc.)
- Email or send notes to parents, administrators, faculty, and staff
- Provide access to copies of previous year summaries for applicable programs (located on PCW website)

> Encourage Participation

- Talk up programs and ask other parents to attend with you as appropriate
- Email or send notes to administrators, faculty, and staff for programs of interest
- Help provide transportation or carpools (optional)
- Make sure everyone knows where, when, and for whom the programs exist

> Attend and Engage

- Go to all programs meant for you and bring a friend where applicable
- Use programs as opportunities to network and engage with other parents

> Share Program Materials

- Once posted, ensure your school community sees and reads program summaries
- Email/hand out program summaries to administrators, faculty, and parents
